GENERAL INFORMATION

The Andersons Premium Lawn Food with Slow Release Nitrogen is one of the finest and most complete turf fertilizers you can buy. Here's why:

Premium Lawn Food provides a diet of nitrogen, potash and iron. This mixture assures that your lawn grows hardy, vigorously and greens quickly - and stays that way longer. Here's what these nutrients do for your lawn...

- Nitrogen promotes the top growth of the grass and produces the deep green color. Premium Lawn Food contains three types of nitrogen - fast, intermediate and slow reacting to give quick response and then steady feeding.
- Potash thickens the wall structure of the grass and makes the grass more vigorous.
- Iron prevents yellowing by aiding the development of chlorophyll in the grass.

HOW TO APPLY

Apply only as directed

Established Lawns:

Apply evenly at 3.6 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. when grass is dry, avoiding skips or misses. Use a spreader designed for granular fertilizer application. Close spreader when turning, stopping and filling. Do not hand spread. Water in for a quicker response. One bag will cover 5,000 sq. ft. (50' x 100').

A lawn will typically utilize 1 to 4 lbs. of nitrogen per 1,000 sq. ft. per growing season. When used as directed, this product will supplement your regular nitrogen program by providing 1.0 lb. of nitrogen at the 3.6 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. application rate. Please consult your local extension office for questions regarding a regular fertilizer program.

For best results, use this product in conjunction with the products listed in The Andersons Lawn Care Program below.

The Andersons Lawn Care Program

- Prevent crabgrass germination and feed in one operation with **The Andersons Premium Crabgrass Preventer plus Lawn Food** - use in April.
- Control broadleaf weeds and dandelions and nourish your grass at the same time with **The Andersons Premium Weed & Feed**. (Make sure grass is wet before applying this product.)
- Raise mowing height to 3" during the summer months.
- Keep mower sharp - rotary blades need sharpening often.
- During droughts, water lawn deeply at weekly intervals. Frequent light sprinkling encourages shallow rooting and wastes water.
- If your lawn does not need crabgrass control or weed control, feed your grass regularly with **The Andersons Premium Lawn Food**. Apply one bag per 5,000 sq. ft. (50' x 100') four times a year - April, June, July, August and October to Kentucky Bluegrass and fescue lawns. For Merion Bluegrass, apply four to five times a year during the growing season.
- Fall is also the best to fertilize. For best results, use The Andersons Premium Fall Lawn Food.
- When starting a new lawn by either seeding or sod, use **The Andersons Premium New Lawn Starter**. For best results, work fertilizer into soil 2-3" before planting.

Apply only to actively growing turf. Do not apply near water, storm drains or drainage ditches. Do not apply if heavy rain is expected. Apply this product only to your lawn, and sweep any product that lands in the driveway, sidewalk, or street, back onto your lawn. Check with your local Cooperative Extension Agency to obtain specific information on local turf best management practices. Check with your county or city government to determine if there are local regulations for fertilizer use.



SPREADER SETTINGS


BROADCAST SPREADER SETTINGS



For best results, applying a circular path starting on the outside and working toward the center (see Broadcast Spreader Path diagram at left). A little overlap of product will ensure complete coverage.

DROP SPREADER SETTINGS



First apply 2 border strips along the edge of each end of the lawn (see Drop Spreader Path diagram at left). Then apply product along the length of the lawn, overlapping slightly and shutting off the spreader before turning as you reach the edge of the border strips.
